Wood Badge is advanced trained in contemporary leadership skills as well as a lot of fun. The training will help you in Scouting, your career and anything you do. All registered adult leaders who have completed Basic Leader Training (Cub Scout, Boy Scout or Venturing) are eligible to attend. There are 2 courses offered in 2007: the spring course at Beaumont (5/18-20 & 6/1-3) and the fall course at Camp Lewallen (8/10-12 & 8/24-26).
